Visiting The Muskerry Bar & Restaurant

This guide will help you know what to do and what to expect when you visit.



Arriving

There is 2 hours, free street parking in front of The Muskerry, and on nearby streets, between 8.30AM - 6.30PM

The streets can be busy so watch out for moving cars and coaches.

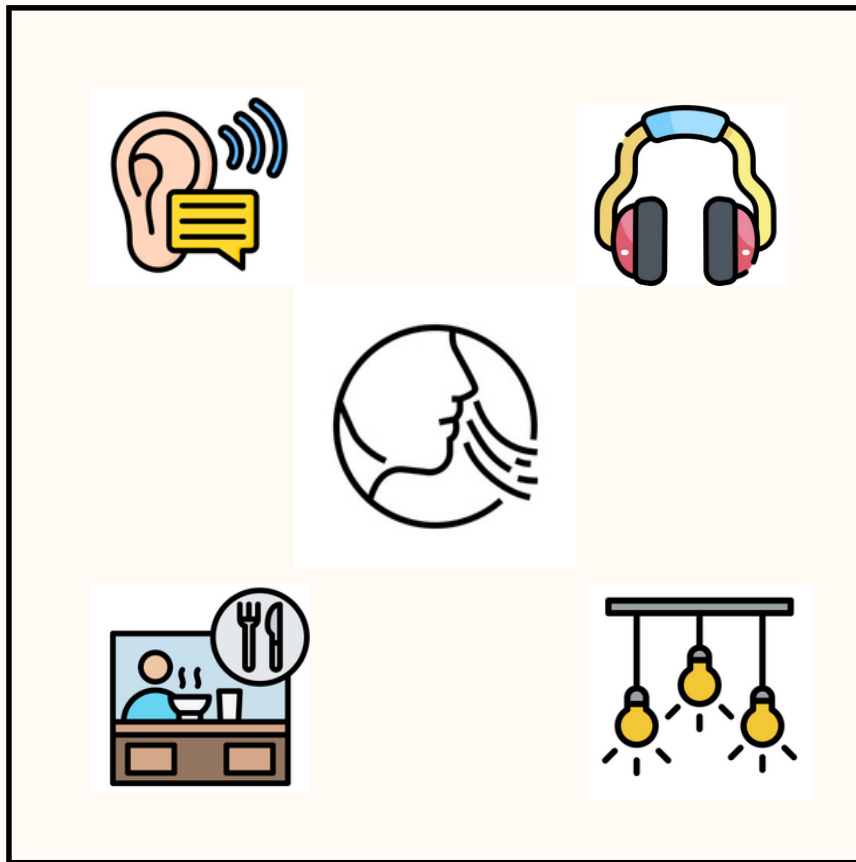


Entering the restaurant

You can enter through of double doors or the small door immediately to the left when you walk in.



You will enter the main bar and restaurant.
You can approach the bar to speak with a staff
member



Sensory Information

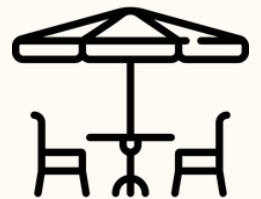
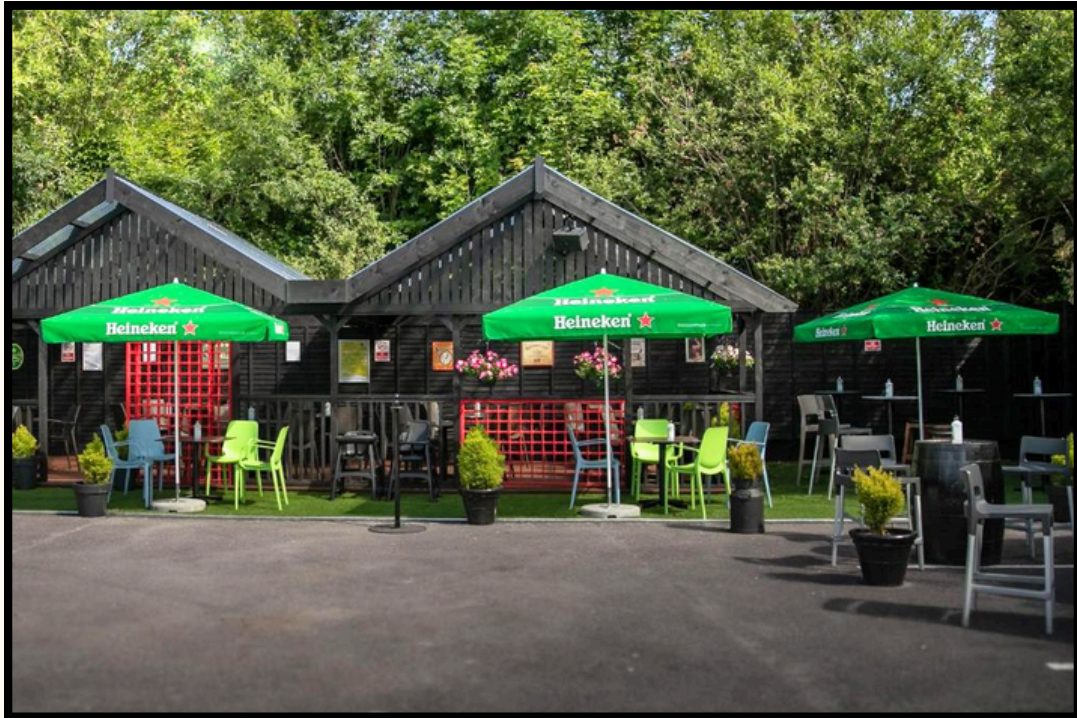
The bar and restaurant can be a busy area with staff and people walking around.
It might be noisy with people talking.
You might hear the cash register and music.
You might smell different food, drinks or cleaning products.



There are lots of seating areas.
You can sit at any empty table or ask a staff member to show you to a suitable table



Upstairs, there is another restaurant area.
This is called Nell's restaurant.
If this is open, you are welcome to sit up here
also. This is a quieter space for dining.



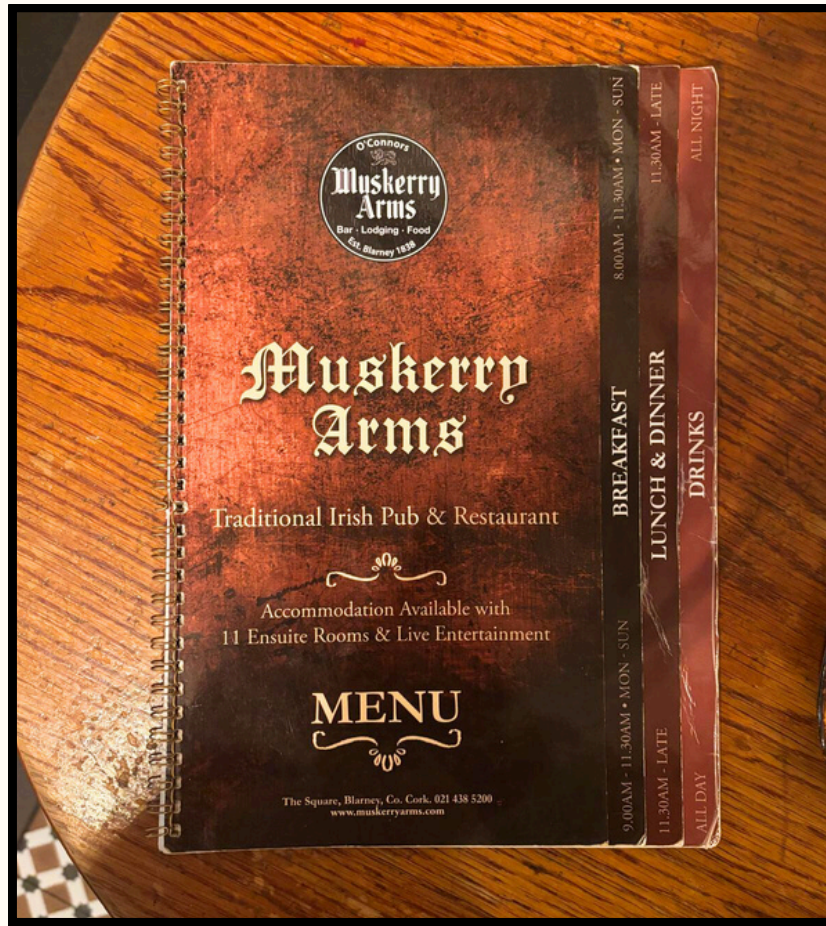
Outside, at the back of the restaurant, there is a large beer garden area.

This area has a bar, lots of seating, and televisions.

This is open during Spring and Summer months, when the weather is fine.

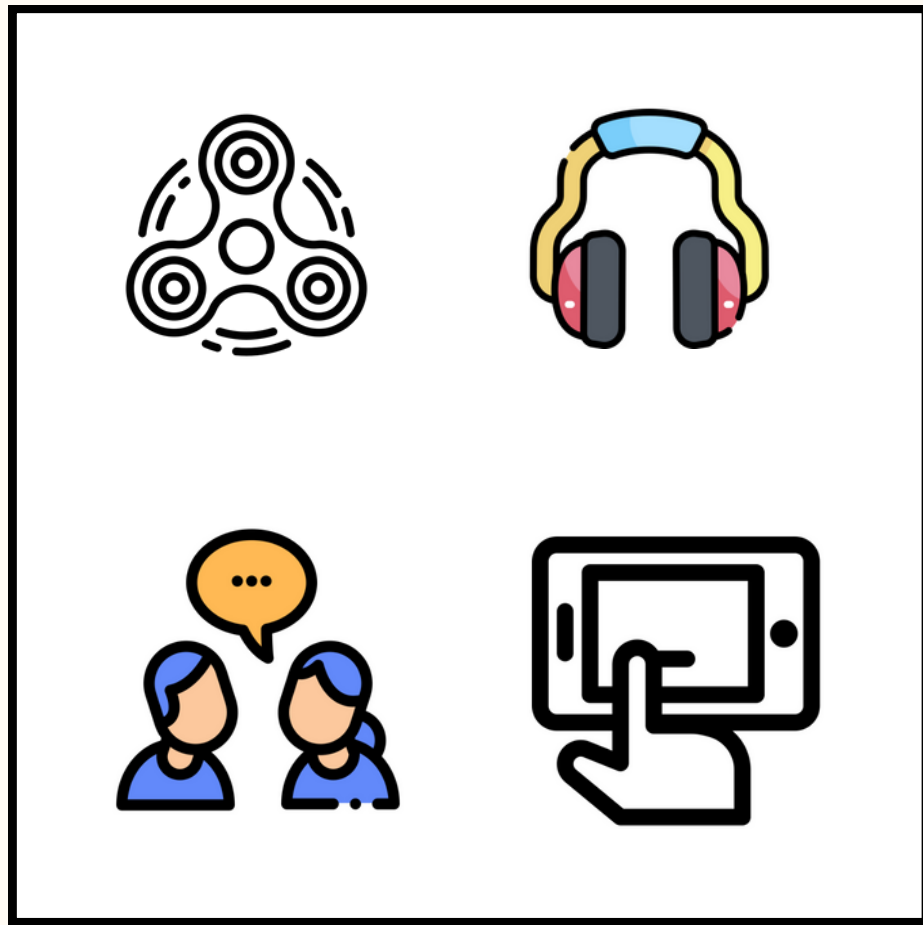


If you ring in advance and let them know that the booking is for an autistic customer, they will reserve the quiet table at the back of the restaurant near the stairs (if available).



You can choose what you would like to eat and drink from the menu.

If you have allergies or preferences you can let the staff know. Staff will take your order for food and drinks at the table.



After you order, you will wait while your food and drinks are being prepared.

You can talk, use your device, use sensory fidgets, or look around while you wait.

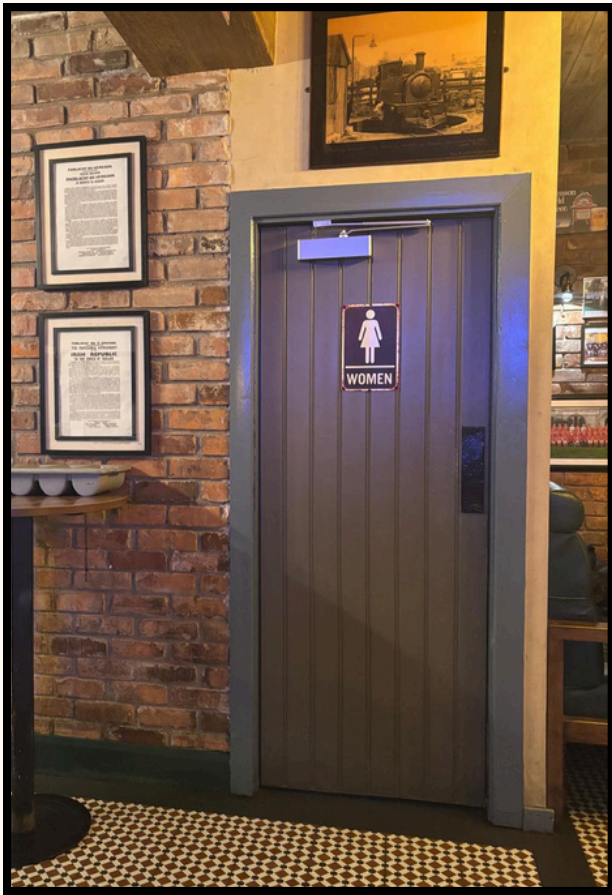
The restaurant has a sensory kit available for you to borrow if needed - just ask a staff member



When your food arrives, you can take your time and enjoy your meal.

If you need anything you can ask the staff.

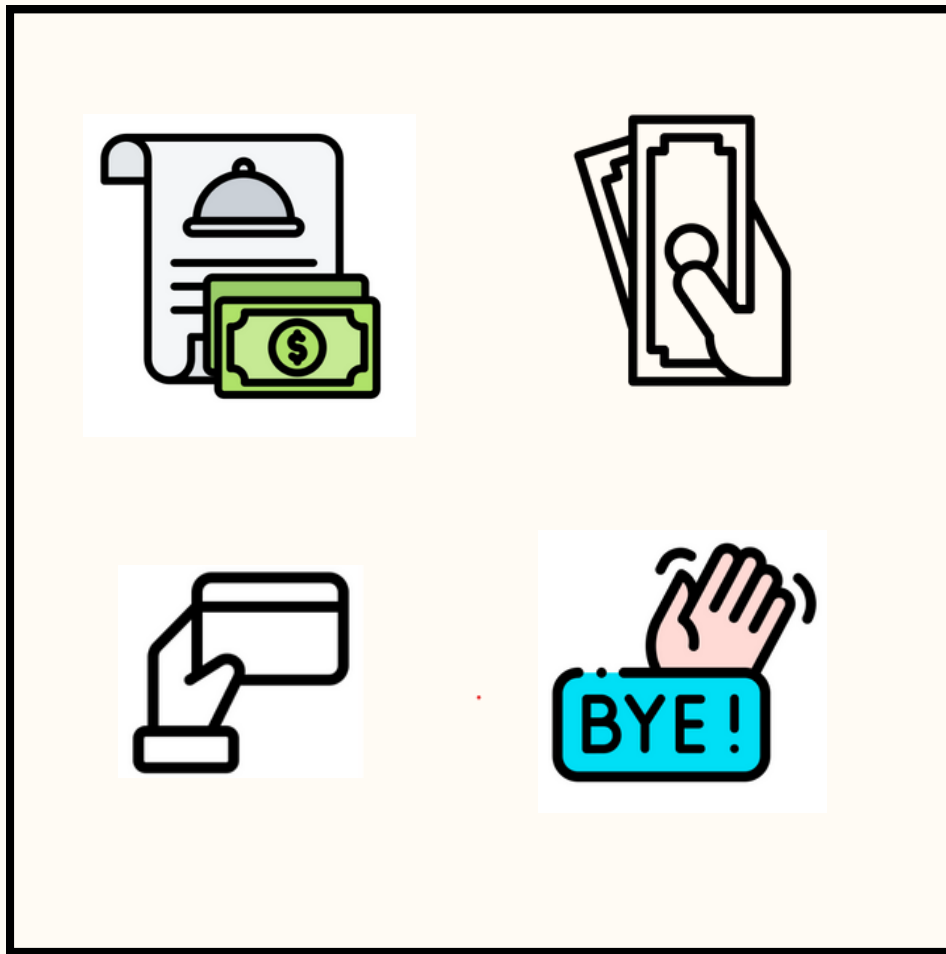
You can use your preferred method of communication, our staff will do their best to help you.



Toilets

Toilets are located both upstairs and downstairs.

Any member of staff will be happy to show you where they are.



When you are done eating, you can ask for your bill and pay for your meal.

You can pay with cash or a card.

When you are ready to leave, you can exit through the same doors that you entered.

The bar & restaurant is quieter in the early afternoon.
