Before coming to fit your floors, Dean might need to measure the room.

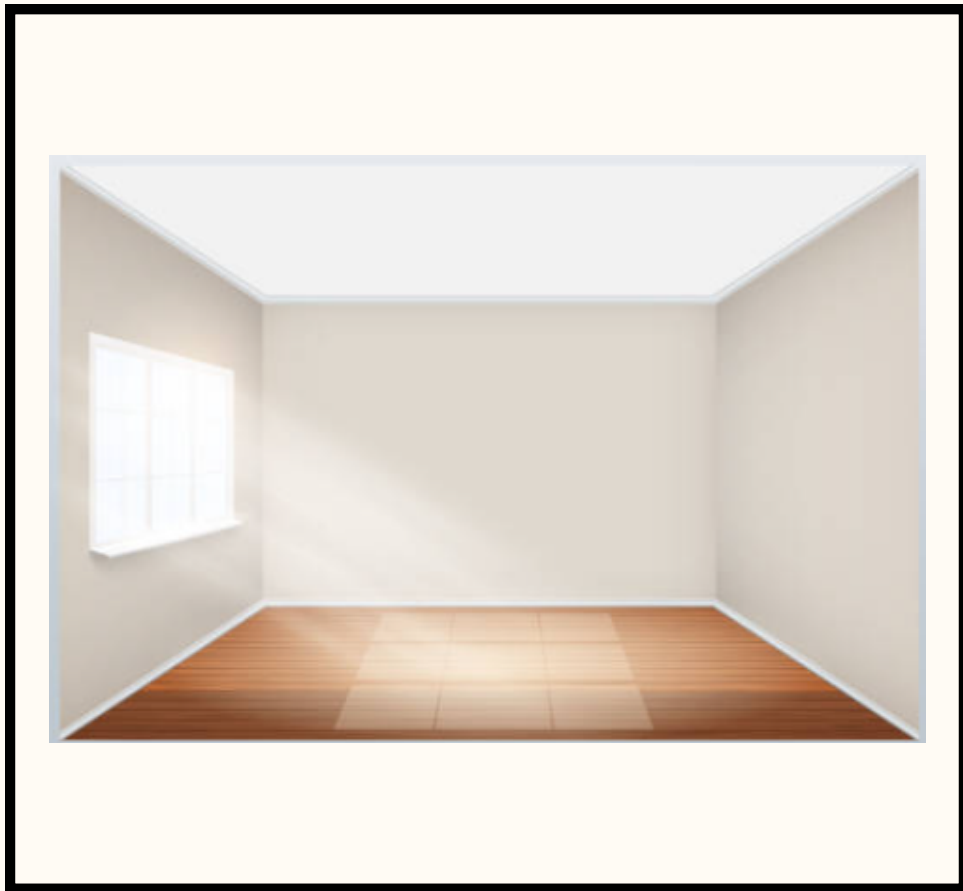
He will use a measuring tape.

Emptying the room



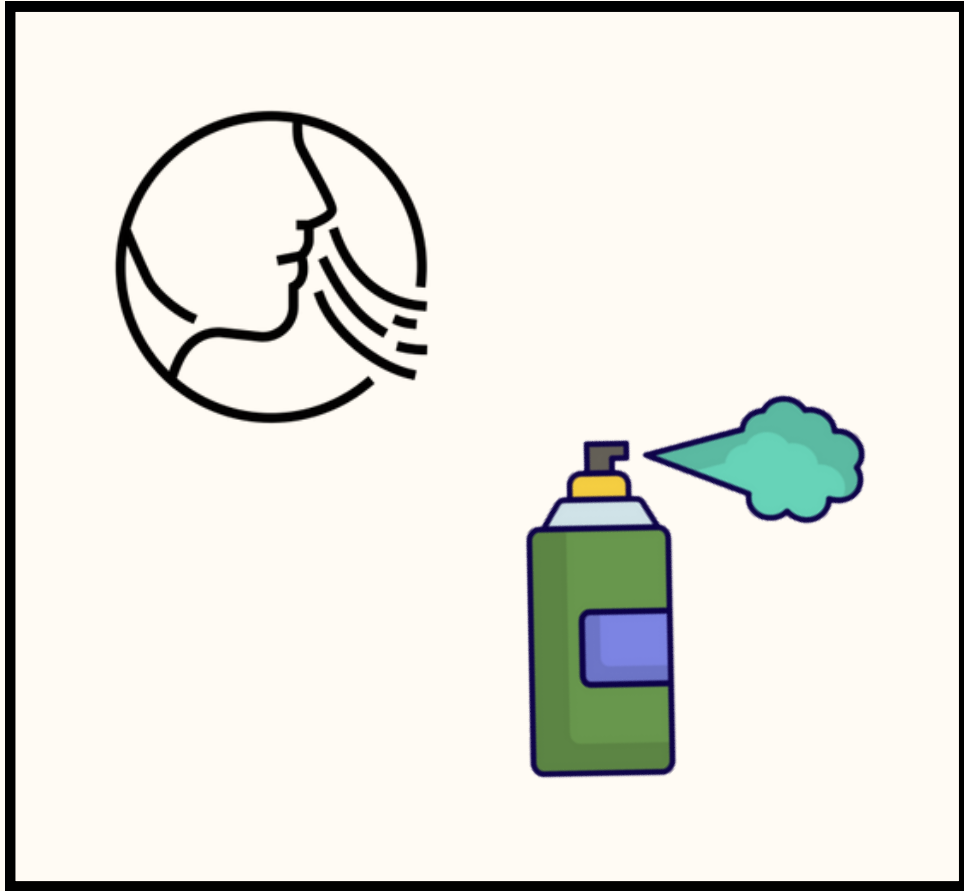
Before Dean arrives, all of the furniture and items will need to be emptied from the room. This is important so Dean can fit the flooring.

He might have a fan and a large hoover.

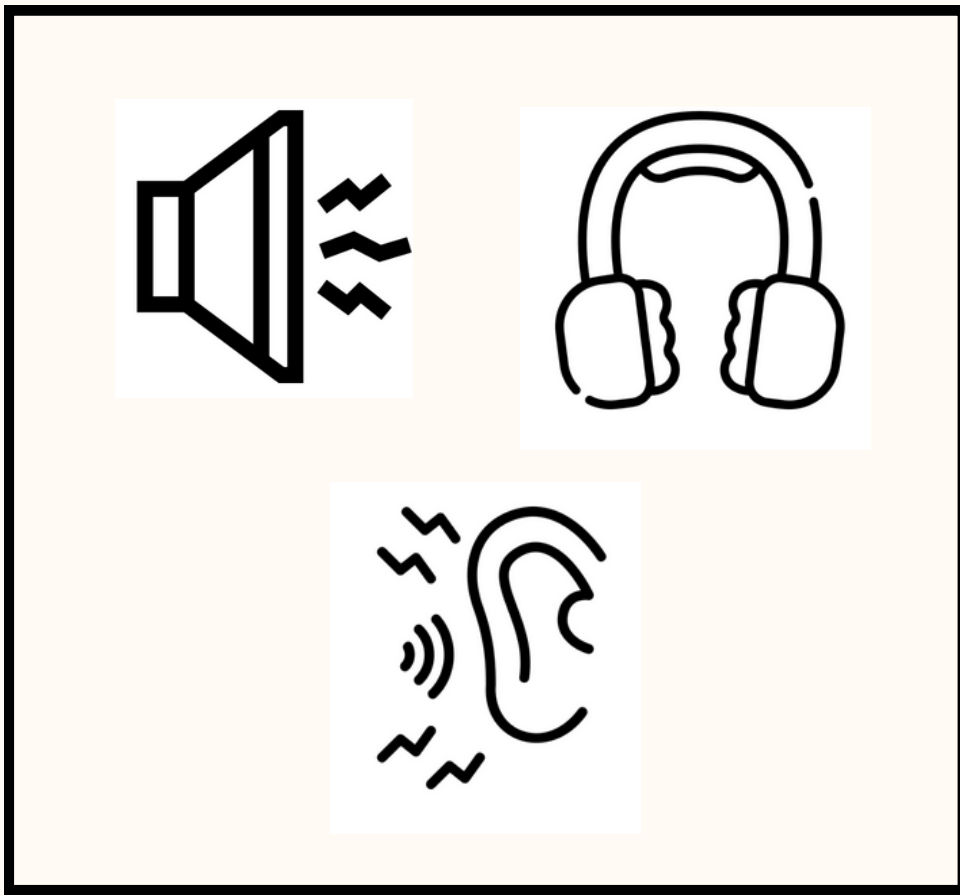
It is important not to touch any of Dean's tools.

Sensory Information

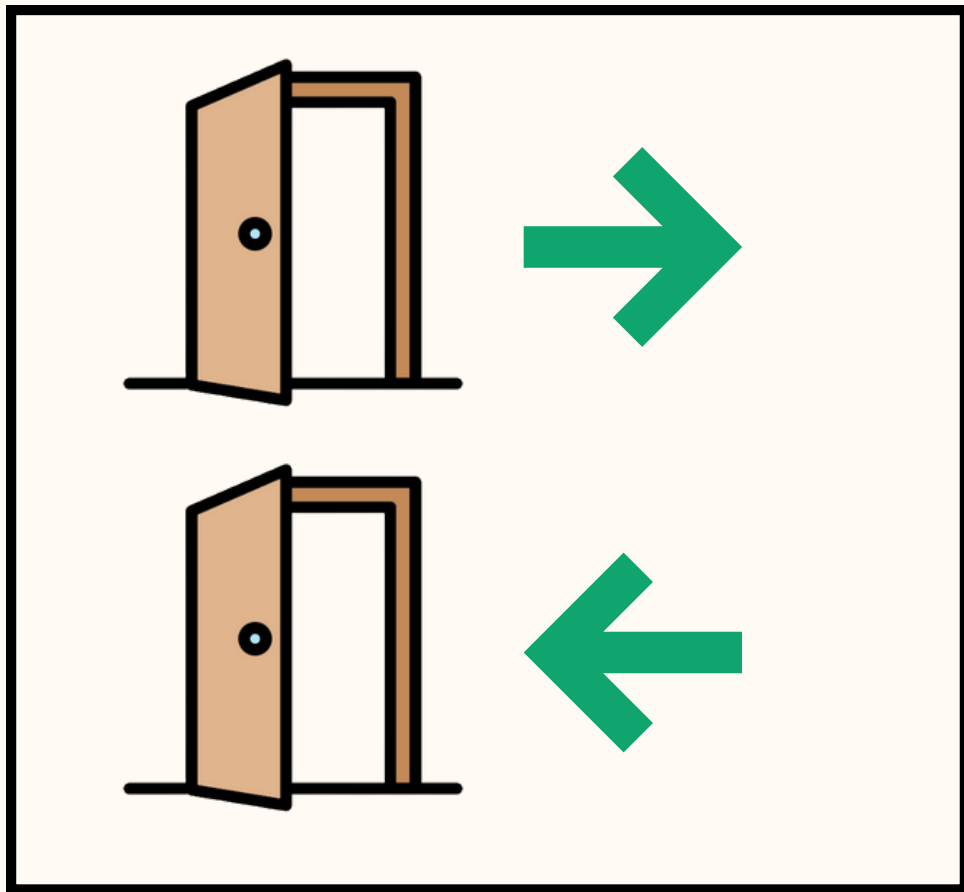
Dean might use spray glue, or wet glue.
These have a very strong unpleasant smell.

You can stay away from the room or stay
outside while this is being used.

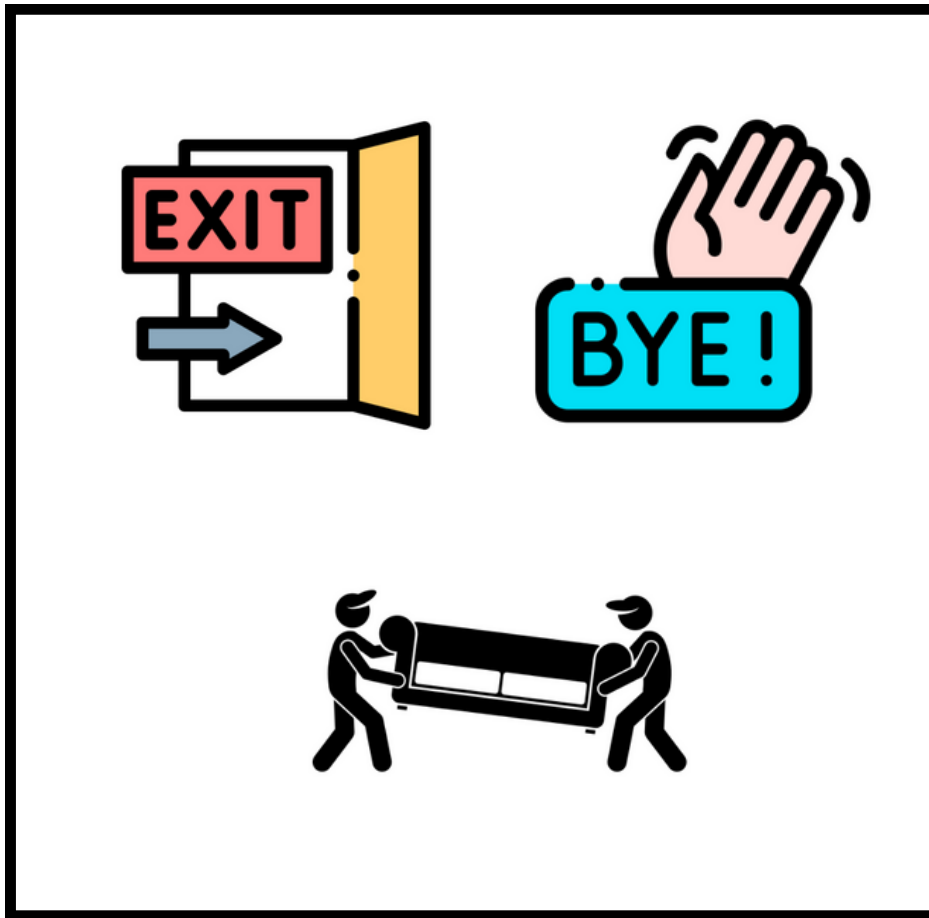


Sensory Information

Dean makes noise when using his tools.
You might hear banging and shuffling.
The fan makes a low humming sound.
The hoover makes a loud suction sound.
You can wear ear defenders to help.



Dean might have to go away and come back the next day if there is a lot of flooring to be done.



When the flooring is fitted, and Dean has finished - he will pack up his tools and say goodbye.

Now you have nice new flooring.
Now your furniture and items can go back into the room.
